Military Court Procedure

Within this document, the recipient shall find the necessary information to host, participate or observe a Military Court hearing, as carried out by a Military Judge hosted by the National Guard of San Andreas.

The Military Court is carried out by a Military Judge hosted by the National Guard of San Andreas, to rule in a matter where civil rights were allegedly violated during times of absence of a Government or the declaration of a period of Martial Law.

Any recipient and holder of an active license to practice law who has achieved the rank of Superior Court Judge or great, may be instated as a temporary Military Court Judge.

Any recipient and holder of an active license to practice law who has achieved the rank of Senior Attorney and below, may be instated as a temporary Military Judge Advocates.

Military Court procedure.

- I. An individual submits a complaint to the Military Court, regarding the misconduct and or violation of civil rights, by a law enforcement officer during a time of the absence of a Government of a period of Martial Law.
- II. The complaint is investigated by a Military Court Judge.
- III. A verdict is reached when the Military Court Judge has reviewed any evidence submitted in relation to said complaint.
