



Article 4. Emergency Vehicles

4.1 Drivers of emergency vehicles may activate flashing lights or a siren in the performance of their duties and if the circumstances are experienced. When the rotating beacons or a siren are activated, drivers of emergency vehicles may benefit from exemptions from certain traffic rules as long as the maneuvers carried out in these circumstances can be done without danger.

4.2 The emergency vehicles are:

- police vehicles;
- ambulances;
- fire safety vehicles.

4.3 The driver of an emergency vehicle with the rotating beacon and siren activated is not required to follow certain rules, including:

- road signs, including traffic lights;
- prescribed speed limits on public roads;
- marking;
- the obligation to use the indicators to indicate the intention to turn, to turn around, to change lanes, etc .;
- the ban on making several successive zigzag passes;
- the prohibition against passing in the opposite lane in and approaching an intersection;
- the ban on overtaking on the right;
- the prohibition to immobilize a vehicle:
 - on a sidewalk,
 - on a limited access path,
 - in a place prohibited by signs.
- the prohibition of:
 - obstruct traffic,
 - make signage ineffective.

4.4 When an emergency vehicle is approaching and its light or sound signals are on, the driver of a road vehicle or the cyclist must:

- give way to him;
- reduce its speed;
- stay to the right of his lane;
- stop when required to ensure the safe passage of the emergency vehicle.



Article 5. Special zones

5.1 A Special Zone is a geographic area defined to the action of special conditions prevailing over the general Traffic Code laws.

5.2 A Special Zone covers the named geographic location and its adjacent territory within a radius of 30 meters (100 ft.)

5.3 The speed limit in the Special Zone must be 60 km / h at all times.

5.4 The list of the Special Zones includes:

- a) Capitol
- b) Station
- c) Central Hospital
- d) FIB HQ
- e) LSPD HQ
- f) SAHP HQ
- g) Casino
- h) Power Plant
- i) Amphitheaters
- j) Auto Fairs
- k) Trade Market

5.5 The violation of a speed limit inside the Special Zones is punishable by a fine of \$15.000.
